First Visit

<u>Sunday Morning Bible Class</u> – "How to Get Visitors and Fallen-Away Members to Come Back"

<u>Sunday AM Sermon</u> – "Challenge to Move Forward" <u>Sunday PM Sermon</u> – Brief devotional, then HANGER SESSION (congregational assessment)

Monday Evening – Introduction to FOUNDATIONS SESSION

Tuesday Evening – Introduction to HABANERO VISITATION MINISTRY

(filling out prospect sheets, discussion)

Wednesday Evening – TAKEOFF SESSION

(planning for top four goals of the congregation)

Between Visits

Make call-backs
Work on conflict resolution
Encourage membership
Work toward top four needs in preparation for next visit
Communicate with preacher and leaders

Second Visit – Circle of Influence

Friday-Sunday or Sunday-Wednesday – Six lessons that teach the congregation the biblical use of the word "measure" and how that applies in their daily lives. How to create, nourish and bring prospects to the Lord will be discussed. This is essential before evangelism training or any lasting church growth.

Third Visit and Beyond

Follow up with congregational needs and plans for church growth. The following are some of the needs churches may have in which HomeMission can assist:
