

On the morning of August 21, 2021, a devastating flood quickly struck the small rural town of **Waverly, TN.** Rapidly rising waters took the lives of 20 people and damaged over 500 homes, 272 of which were destroyed in the span of less than one hour. The **Waverly Church of Christ** (ministers **Jeff Keele** – pulpit; **Kyle Mashburn** – youth), praising God that their building was spared, immediately reached out to provide shelter and assistance to their community. The **Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort** immediately launched into action and the church served as a base for those actions. Now more than 14 months and over 600 families later, the church and volunteers in the community are still heavily involved in the disaster relief efforts and response from continuing to prepare and serve hundreds of meals weekly to volunteer workers and those in need, to coordinating physical building repairs/reconstruction, assembling and **delivering appliances and furniture**, and **comforting a still grieving community** as it moves forward with recovery. The congregation, physically and emotionally weary, is still strongly committed to and engaged with meeting the physical needs of the community. The church also recognizes the need to reach out to meet spiritual needs and share the Good News. God has blessed the congregation with more than 11 baptisms in its post-flood efforts.

In early fall of 2022, following a virtual meeting with **Jim Lucas**, the elders invited **HomeMission** to visit Waverly for the purpose of aiding in the spiritual outreach to the community and to support evangelistic efforts going forward. The primary focus of this visit was to assess the **Disaster Relief Effort** contacts, and develop a strategy for follow up. On November 6-9, the HomeMission team of Jim Lucas, Bill and Kathy Hardy, and Joe and Darla Ferguson met onsite at Waverly Church of Christ to plan, organize, train, and demonstrate how to transition from providing physical needs to providing spiritual needs through sharing the Gospel of Christ. Through God's timing and blessing, this was the first opportunity for HomeMission and Gospel Sharing Ministries to collaborate in methods and training at a congregation. Jim spoke at a combined morning class and worship; Bill spoke Sunday night. Bill and Joe continued for an additional week and a half, teaching the HM and GSM tools in classes on Sundays and Wednesdays. Kathy and Darla helped train two of the sisters of the congregation who assisted our team with the spiritual outreach effort. The **HomeMission** team assessed 142 Disaster Relief Effort contacts, created packets including street maps for multiple outreach teams, and conducted over 40 in-home visits; several visits included local church members learning the GSM approach to sharing the Gospel. Plans are being developed for the next steps and follow up visit back to Waverly in May God continue to grant the Waverly brethren strength and guidance as they continue to serve their community. May God guide **HomeMission** as we seek to support Waverly in their desire to reach their community. To God be the glory. Great things He has done, and will do!

BRRRR. November started out with a blast of cold air. But the **Ohio Valley trip** was a great start to the month. We worked with three churches and met with representatives of three more. We brought books and different materials to these churches. One of those churches was the Barlow-Vincent church of Christ in Vincent Ohio. They had grown by 40 in attendance since we were there last. They have a great young preacher and spiritually minded Elders. They are a great example of what God can do if a congregation will work, invite, and connect. We gave Nathan Greene, their evangelist, some books entitled, "I Died Last Night". He wrote, "I gave Betty the book, "I died last night" on Wednesday. She came this morning and was baptized. Now we work on her husband. Thanks so much for taking the time to come and be with us at Barlow Vincent."

God's handiwork through **HomeMission year to date information**:

- 1) We have worked with and assisted in some way over **100 churches** this year.
- 2) Churches have reported **367 baptisms** and **4 restorations** (this is by no means all).
- 3) **5 campaigns** held by **Gospel Sharing** and one partnering with the **West Freeway School of Evangelism.**
- 4) We have given away over **200,000 worth of materials.**
- 5) **6 churches** have requested assistance or have been referred to us in the last month.
- 6) **Four churches** have been helped this month by **HomeMission** first responders. We currently have fifteen **first responders**, active or pending.
- 7) We have received two more requests to help start congregations, one in **Texas** and one in **Wisconsin**. This will make **7 new start-up churches HomeMission** has assisted in the past 7 years. This is a new area of work we need in the United States.



From the Field






