

Church Spotlight



Bostonia church of Christ

Located in El Cajon California, part of the greater San Diego area, is the **Bostonia Church of Christ** that assembles about one hundred Saints every Lord's Day. Last month on December 14, 2022, this congregation rejoiced greatly as they installed two elders after having gone many years without. Although they had been blessed with a long-time preacher and an active membership still recovering from the COVID pandemic, the congregation was led by a committee of the men of the congregation in the absence of elders.

HomeMission evangelist **Mike King** and his wife **Kathleen** visited some of the San Diego area churches in the Fall of 2021. The Bostonia congregation was receptive to the **HomeMission** introduction given by Mike, which resulted in an abbreviated *LAUNCH* session for its Men's Business Committee. As a result of the *LAUNCH* session, the men identified several goals for the congregation of which pursuing an eldership was one. Additionally, the committee set another goal of a youth minister. Upon returning to the Bostonia congregation in 2022 for a follow up- visit, the Kings were excited to see the presence of a youth minister, who actively fills in for the pulpit minister as necessary, and the congregation moving forward in the eldership process, which was accomplished several months later.

May God bless the newly installed elders, **David McKinsey** and **Garry Kitchell**, and **Michael Turner**, the youth minister.

From the Director

Dear lived ones in the Lord,

January begins our 8th year of operations for HomeMission for Susie and me. It has been seven hard fought long years of encouraging, equipping, and training in evangelism. Many lives have been touched, many souls have come to Christ, many churches have turned around, and many have struggled with the pandemic. Yet, in all this, and in many ways, we have only begun our work. Some churches that have had success, made poor decisions, which reversed the growth. Others have not gone forward. Many have died, moved and fell away in the last three years. BUT, overall, God has given a great increase that is just now beginning.

The West Freeway School of evangelism is underway. The school has been successful so far. They are now conducting their field work assignments. Chris Graham, the director and his crew are doing a great work. Also, we are encouraging more preachers already in the field with outreach tools.

HomeMission is now working with churches willing to do follow-up from disasters. Several dozen have obeyed the gospel already.

Gospel sharing has become a great partner with evangelism follow-up as well as other larger churches.

HomeMission evangelists are continually contacting more churches and starting more training than ever before.

New materials are coming out for congregations to use for church growth and evangelism.

Revive us again, church growth workshop, will be in Waxahachie Texas (March) and for the first time, in Florence Alabama (June).

Elder's Net is now going to over 400 elders in 25 states once a quarter.

We are starting the process of assisting church planting in areas where the church has died or has never existed in our nation.

All of this is accomplished through and by the Will and Power of God. AND, supported and assisted by all of you who follow HomeMission. But this work is difficult, time consuming and expensive. Accomplishments God has accomplished through HomeMission in 2022

- --Churches have reported **385 baptisms** this past year
