#### 2023 tax information

All donations given to HomeMission which are to be counted on 2023 tax returns must be received in the office and/or postmarked on or before December 31, 2023. The law does not allow us to issue tax letters for 2023 for anything received after this date, even though it may be dated before. Tax letters will be sent out by January 31, 2024.

# Statistics / Fund-Raising Drive

- 1. HomeMission has worked in some way with 115 congregations in 30 states so far, this year.
- 2. HomeMission is following up with 11 churches in four states that have had disasters and received assistance from disaster relief efforts.
- 3.HomeMission has given over tens of thousands of dollars worth of material (retail value) to churches around the country.
- 4. HomeMission is currently working with five start up congregations in 4 states.
- 5. We now have 11 evangelists and three more are interested.
- 6. HomeMission conducted two four-day conferences in Texas and Alabama (Heritage Christian University campus)
- 7. Churches have reported 641 baptisms so far this year. (Over 1000 the past 22 months)
- 8. HomeMission evangelists have travelled over tens of thousands of miles so far this year.
- 9. Elder'sNet (a quarterly publication for elders by elders) is being sent out to over 472 elders in 30 states representing 146 congregations.
- 10. The West Freeway School of Evangelism graduated its first 3 students in August and started year two with 3 students during the day and 13 students once a week on Monday evenings.
- 11. Six larger congregations have worked with seven smaller ones through HomeMission. Three more have committed to help next year.
- 12. Of the 600 plus churches HomeMission has worked with over the past 7 years in some way, less than 2% have closed, while 125 other churches in America are closing their door each year.
- 13. All praise and glory go to Jesus our Savior and King.
