Statistics for April 2024

Statistics for **HomeMission** through April 2024

- 1. We have worked with **75 congregations** (in some way) in **22 states** so far this year. We are following up with **nine churches in five states** that have had **disasters** and **received assistance** from **disaster relief efforts.**
- 3. We have given out thousands of workbooks, materials, Bibles, tracts, and other tools to churches around the country.
- 4. **HomeMission** is continuing to work with four start up congregations in four states. We are now trying to assist a couple in Wisconsin in starting a new church.
- 5. We now have 13 evangelists, with several that are being trained.
- 6. **HomeMission** plans to conduct two four-day conferences. REVIVE TEXAS (April 24-27—532 in attendance from 68 congregations in 11 states) REVIVE ALABAMA (June 12-15)
- 7.. Churches have reported 341 baptisms so far this year through the end of March. While 721 were reported last year.
- 8. Elder'sNet (a quarterly publication for elders by elders) is being sent out to over 472 elders in 30 states representing 146 congregations.
- 9. The **West Freeway School of Evangelism** graduated its first three students in August and started year two with three students who finished their classes last year. They are now doing their field work. We already have five new students signed up for August of this year, and many more have shown interest.
- 10. 10 larger congregations have committed to work with 10 smaller ones through **HomeMission**.
- 11. Of the 600 plus churches **HomeMission** has worked with over the past eight years in some way, less than 2% have closed, while around 100 other churches in America are closing their doors each year.
- 12. **14 churches** have **requested information eight churches** have been assigned an evangelist to work with them; six churches have future dates.
- 12.All praise and glory go to Jesus our Savior and King.
