# **HomeMission Statistics**

Statistics for **HomeMission** through May 2024

- 1. We have worked with **86 congregations** (in some way) in **23 states** so far this year. We are following up with **9 churches in 5 states** that have had disasters and received assistance from disaster relief efforts.
- 2. We have given out thousands of **workbooks**, **materials**, **Bibles**, **tracts**, and other tools to churches around the country.
- 3. **HomeMission** is continuing to work with **4 start up congregations in 4 states.** We are now trying to assist a couple in **Wisconsin** in starting a new church.
- 4. We now have **13 evangelists**, with several that are being trained.
- 5. **HomeMission** conducted 2 four-day conferences. **REVIVE TEXAS** (April 24-27—532 in attendance from 68 congregations in 11 states) **REVIVE ALABAMA** will be **June 12-15**
- 6. Churches have reported **463 baptisms** so far this year through the end of May. While 721 were reported last year.
- 7. **Elder'sNet** (a quarterly publication **for elders by elders)** is being sent out to over **472 elders in 30 states** representing **146 congregations.**
- 8.The West Freeway School of Evangelism graduated its first 3 students in August and started year two with 3 students who finished their classes last year. They are now doing their field work. We already have 5 new students signed up for August of this year, and many more have shown interest.
- 9. **Ten larger congregations are working with 10 smaller ones** through **HomeMission**.
- 10. Of the **600 plus churches HomeMission** has worked with over the past 8 years in some way, less than 2% have closed, while around 100 other churches in America are closing their doors each year.
- 11. All praise and glory go to Jesus our Savior and King.
